

Mrs. Phillips' Weekly Focus February 4th-11th, 2019



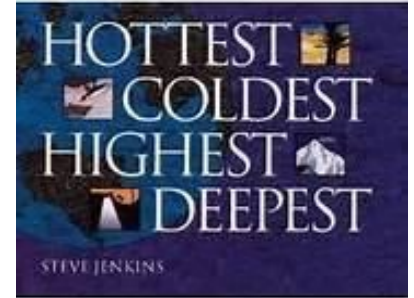

Spelling (LA Standard 3.W.6.2)

The Spelling List 20 deals with r controlled sounds. The list was distributed Friday, the 2nd. Some students have 15 words, some have 20, and some have 25. There will be a **trial test** on Wednesday and a **final test** on Friday. The list can be found on the Parent Information page under Spelling Lists.

English (LA Standard 3.W.6.1)

This week's grammar skill is subject and object pronouns. We will review nouns, verbs and basic sentence structure. There will be a **grammar quiz** on Friday.

Subject Pronouns

Subject Pronoun is a pronoun used as the subject of a sentence.

Subject Pronouns: I, you, he, she, it, we, they

Example: She hiked in the desert.

He and I stayed home.

James, you must learn to take risks.

Object Pronouns

Object Pronoun is a pronoun used after an action verb or as the object of a preposition. It is always in the predicate part of the sentence.

Object Pronouns: me, you, him, her, it, us, them

Example: The plants surprised her.

She told him and me about them.

We will also be working on a writing project similar to one that will be on the ILearn test in April. (LA Standard 3.W.3.1, 3.W.3.3, 3.W.4, 3.W.6)

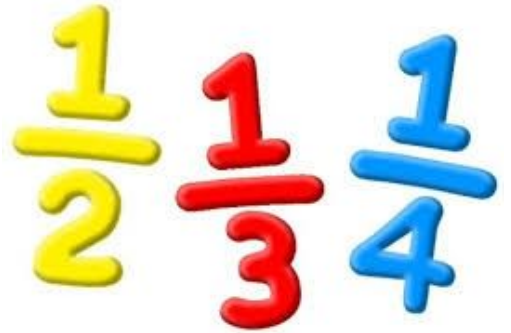
