This week is a review week. We will review the skills taught in Unit 4 (cause-effect, fact-opinion, graphic sources, and generalizing) There will be homework on Monday and Tuesday that will need to be signed by a parent or responsible adult. Om Friday we will take the Unit test.

Spelling (LA Standard 3.W.6.2)

English (LA Standard 3.W.6.1)

We will review the grammar skills, of pronouns (singular, plural, object, subject, possessive), contractions, and prepositions. There will be a **grammar test** on Friday. A study guide for bonus points will come home Monday and be due on Thursday.



We are also focusing on writing this week. We will do some lessons based on last week's writing prompt and do so opinion writing.

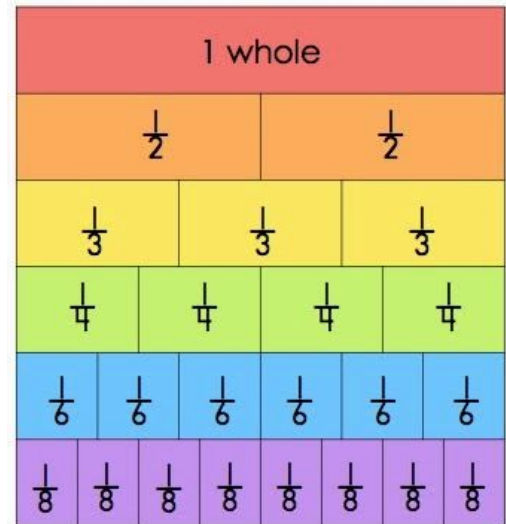
